What is a Protected Tree?

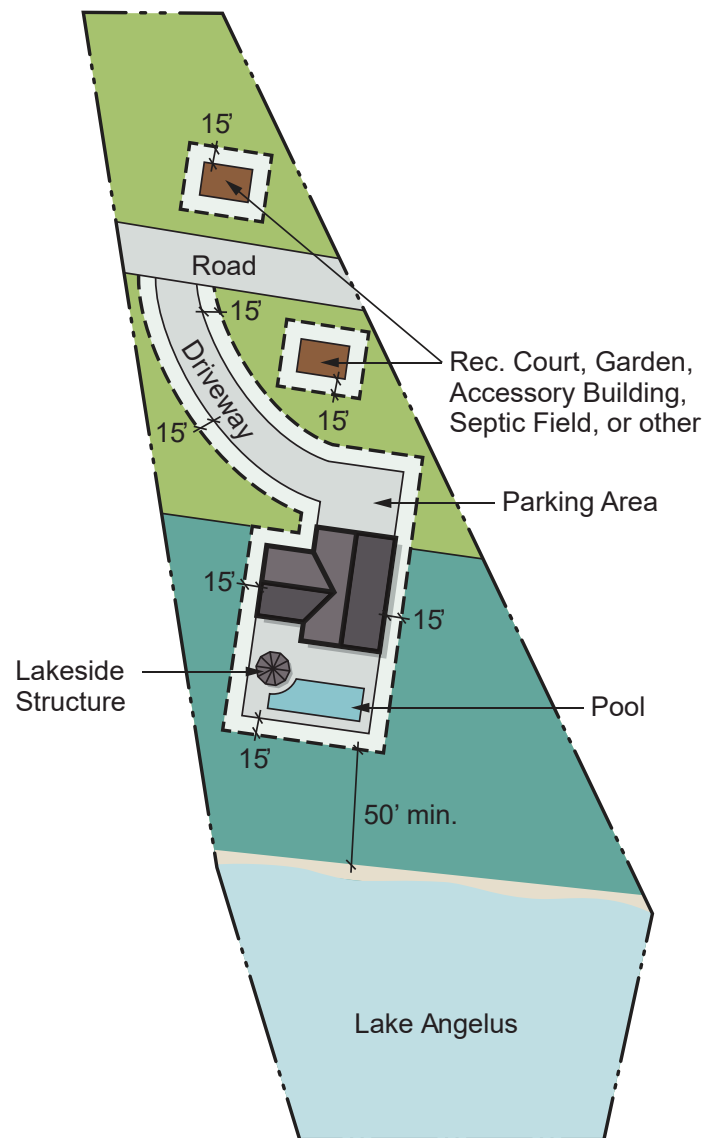
- » **In the Lakeside Tree Preservation Area:**
4" diameter trunk (or 2" diameter on steep slopes) or greater
- » **In the Roadside Tree Preservation Area:**
8" diameter or greater

Why are trees so important in Lake Angelus?

- » Trees define the character of the community, creating a lush view from the Lake and neighboring homes;
- » Tree canopy is essential to our "up north feel" and helps preserve and grow our property values;
- » Trees provide a buffer against light pollution;
- » Trees enhance air quality, provide shade, minimize erosion to the lake, and improve water absorption.

Before You Build

Adding to the canopy: For each new structure, one tree will be planted on the lake side of a property for every 500 sq. ft. of building that is approved.
